

Team Lists

Team Lists must be handed in 15 minutes prior to the start of the game to the Bench Officials table. Once the team list is handed in, there cannot be any changes until the whistle has blown for the start of the game. The only exception to this is when a player is injured during warm up.

When completing the team list, please ensure it is in alphabetical order by surname first and then initial of the first name. If you have two players with the same surname and same first initial, please write the players first name in full as well.

Names listed on the Team List are the people who can sit on your team bench, so if you have an injured player who will not be taking the court and you want them to sit on your team bench they must be on the list. You can name them as an assistant coach or Primary Carer 2.

Substitution Forms

It is the Managers responsibility to ensure that they complete the substitutions forms for **ALL** substitutions including tactical changes, as well as injuries. You will need to be prompt on handing these forms in to the bench to ensure they have the correct

information for stats etc. The bench can only do their job effectively when they have the correct information.

The players names and numbers need to be the same order on both the Team List and Substitution forms

The bench will be recording the substitution forms onto the new Game Management form which will be handed into the office and this is the form that will determine players eligibility for finals.

Score Sheets

New score sheets have come in with the rule changes, however, we will be using up our stock of current score sheets and once these have run out we will switch to the new score sheets. The exception to this will be 2-3 weeks prior to NZ Opens bench officials selected to attend the opens will be practising using the new score sheets and we will email you copies of these at the end of the night.

The main differences between the new score sheet and the old one are as follows

- Substitutions made during the quarter will no longer be shown on the main score sheet but will now be shown on the new Game Management Form
- There will no longer be a separate shooting stats form and it will be shown at the bottom of the score sheet
- Previously if the shooter missed a goal from a penalty this would be indicated with a P now it will only be indicated with a dot
- Previously if the shooter got a goal from a penalty the number would be circled there will no longer be any circles so the score sheet will look like this
